- Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) Bronze Medallion (or equivalent)
- SLSA IRB Driver Certificate (or equivalent)
- Provide First Aid Certificate
- C Class Drivers Licence (Manual)
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate
- National Police Clearance
- 800m pool swim in 14 minutes or less
- Complete Lifeguard Mission
